Logomark



Primary Logo

The primary logomark is the core of the Evolv brand and should be prominent across all touchpoints. The logomark combines bold, custom typography with a graphic element that can be used as a visual shorthand.



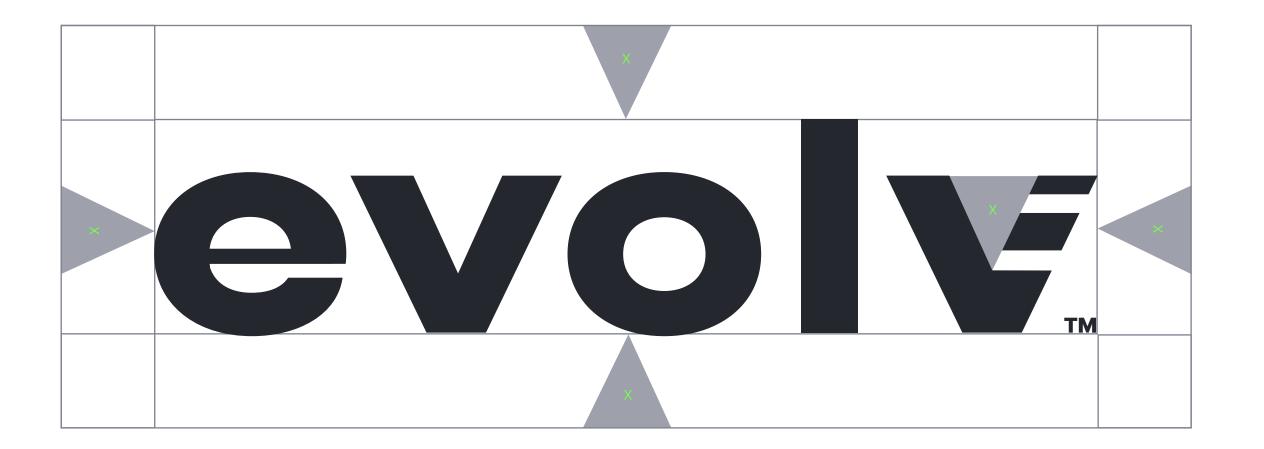


CLEARSPACE

Primary Logo

To ensure that the nameplate is used consistently, the space around the logomark must remain uninterrupted.

The clear space unit is defined by using the triangular counter-space of the extractable peelable embedded in the logomark as seen in the diagram on the right.

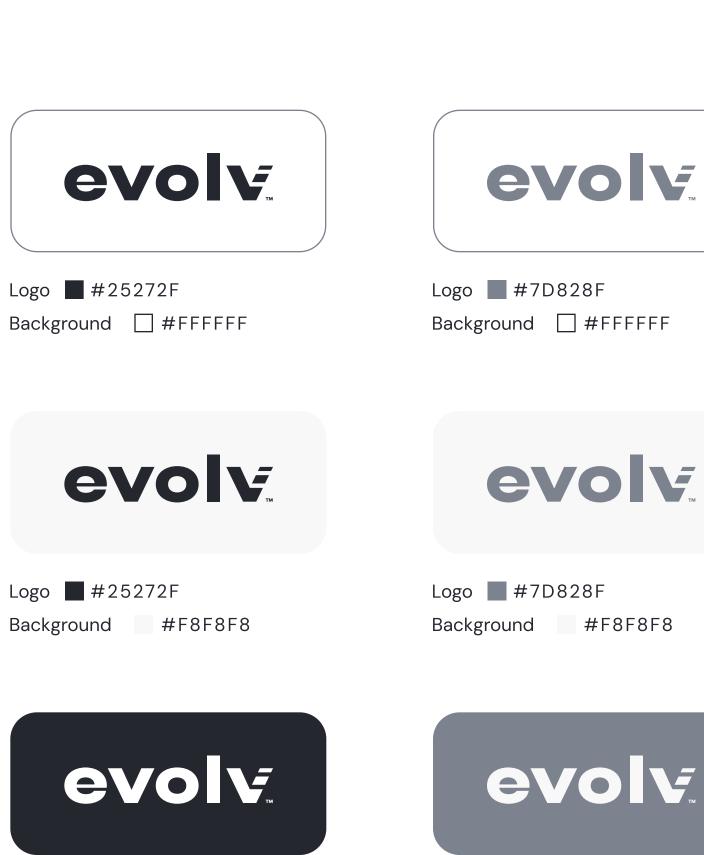

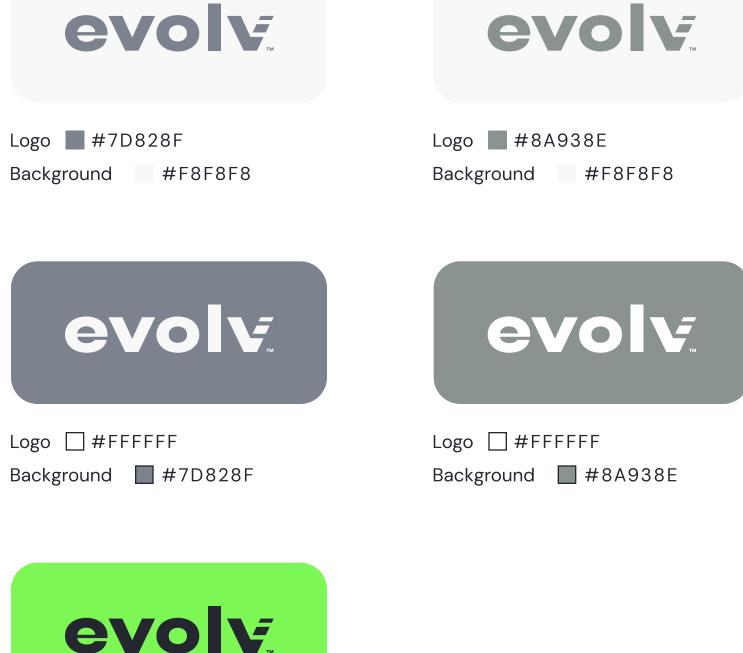

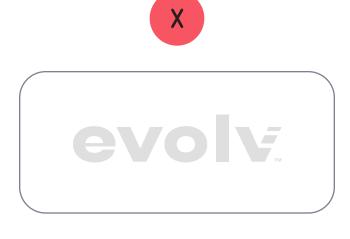
Primary Logo

Building consistency with logo usage is important for brand recognition. Follow these rules when using the primary logo:

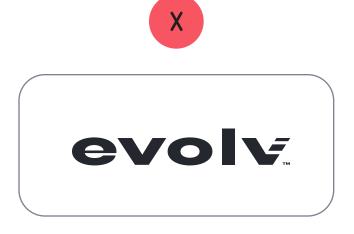
- Use the approved colors listed on the previous page.
- Use appropriate clearspace and sizing.
- Do not stretch or manipulate the logo.
- Do not alter or remove parts of the logo.
- Do not change the opacity of the logo.
- Make sure that the logo image is not low resolution or blurry.



Do not use non-approved colors.



Do not change the opacity.



Do not stretch or manipulate.





Do not add a stroke.



Do not use low-resolution images.





Do not add non-approved words or objects.



Companion Mark

The Evolv peelable is a reduction of the logomark. It can be used as a standalone element.

To establish brand equity, the logomark should be the default choice whenever possible. Over time, the peelable will be as recognizable as the primary nameplate.



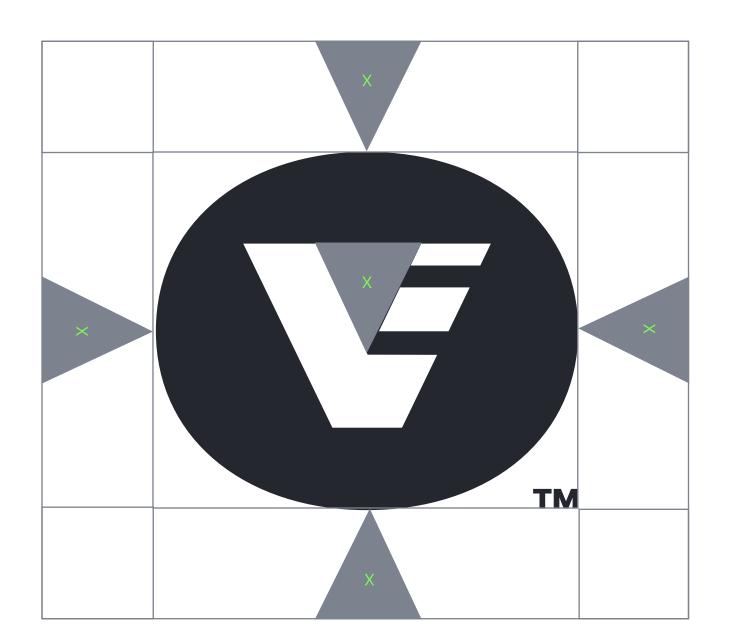

To ensure the peelable is used consistently, the space around the peelable must remain uninterrupted.

The clear space unit is defined by using the triangular counter-space of the peelable as seen in the diagram on the right.

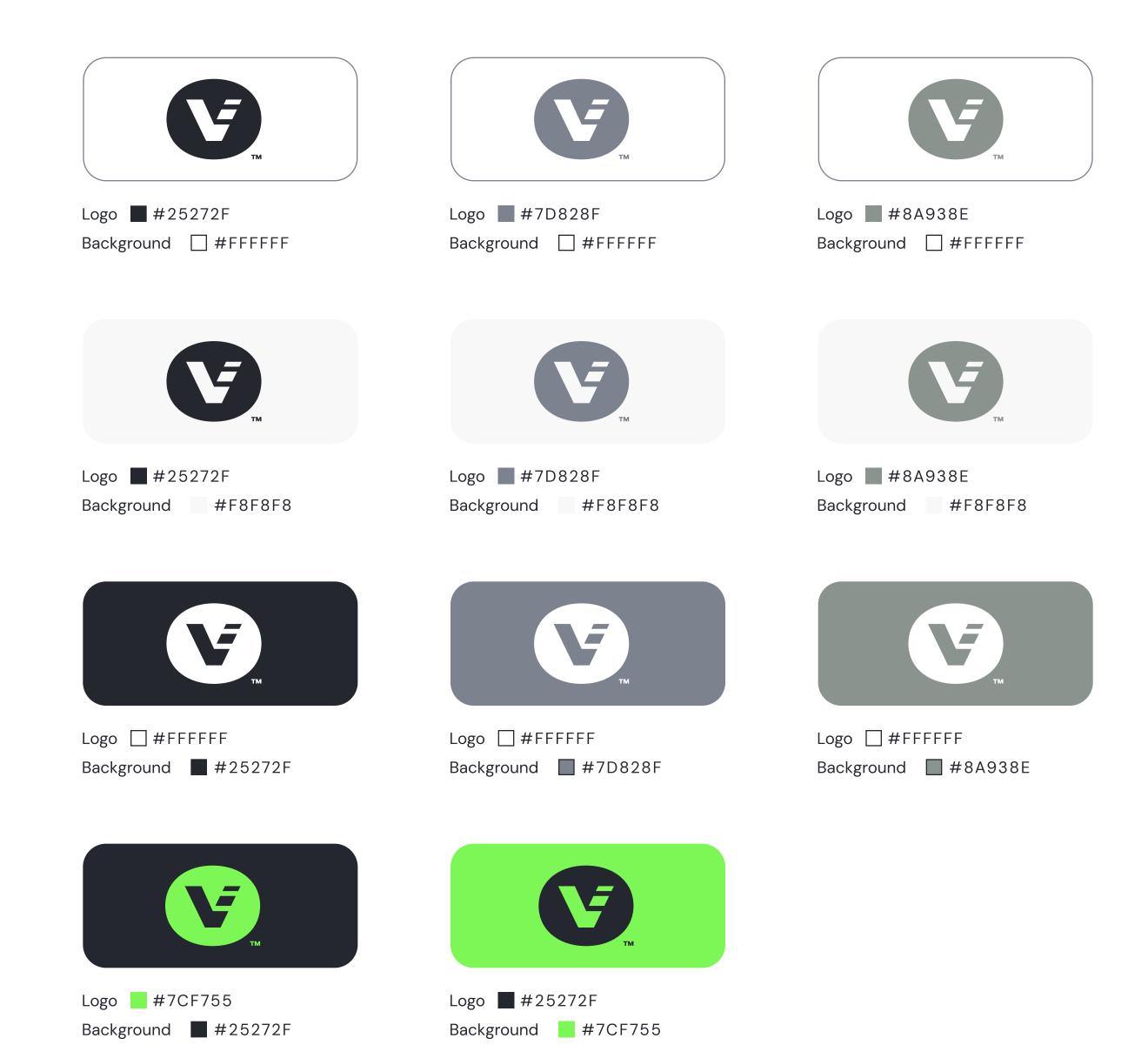

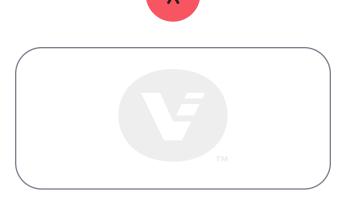
Companion Mark

Building consistency with logo usage is important for brand recognition. Follow these rules when using the Companion Mark:

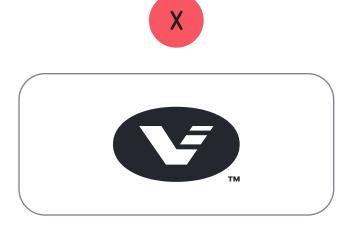
- Use the approved colors listed on the previous page.
- Use appropriate clearspace and sizing.

- Do not change the opacity of the logo.
- Make sure that the logo image is not low resolution or blurry.

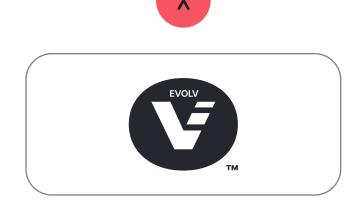

LOGO USAGE

Logomark System

The Evolv logomark system consists of a primary logomark, a "Powered by" logomark, and a "Secured by" logomark and a companion mark.

Primary Logomark: The primary logomark should be used in most cases. Optically balanced, it is the preferred way for the brand to be represented. This is the default.

"Powered by" Logomark: These are a verification of the use of Evolv technology, and should be showcased on Evolv's product and other products or initiatives that Evolv technology makes possible.

Companion Mark: The companion mark should be used in special cases where the primary logomark will not fit, resulting in poor legibility, or where they may seem ungainly. For example, the companion mark might be used as a social profile avatar.

The primary color palette focuses mainly on blacks, grays, and the Evolv Safe Green.

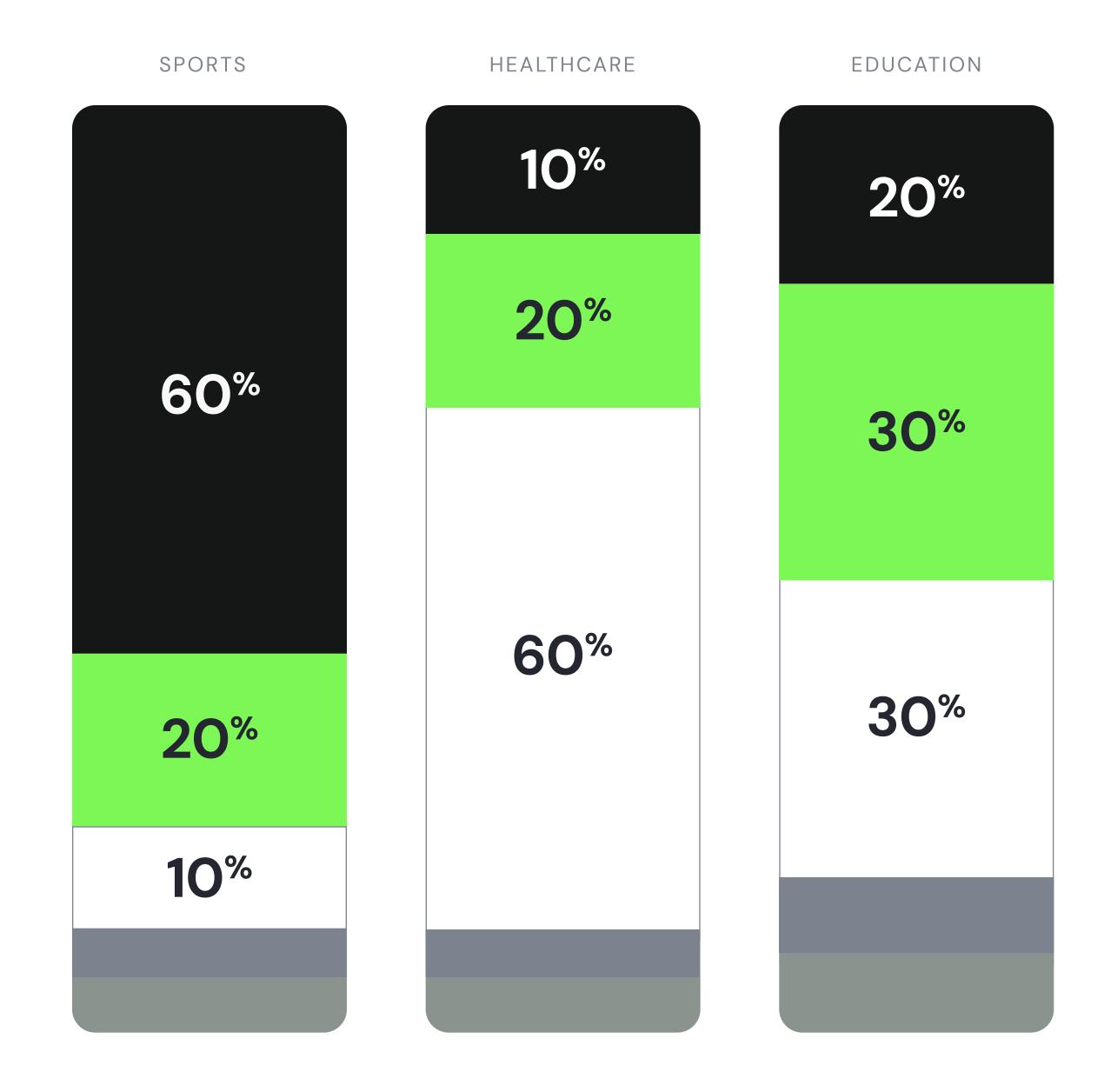

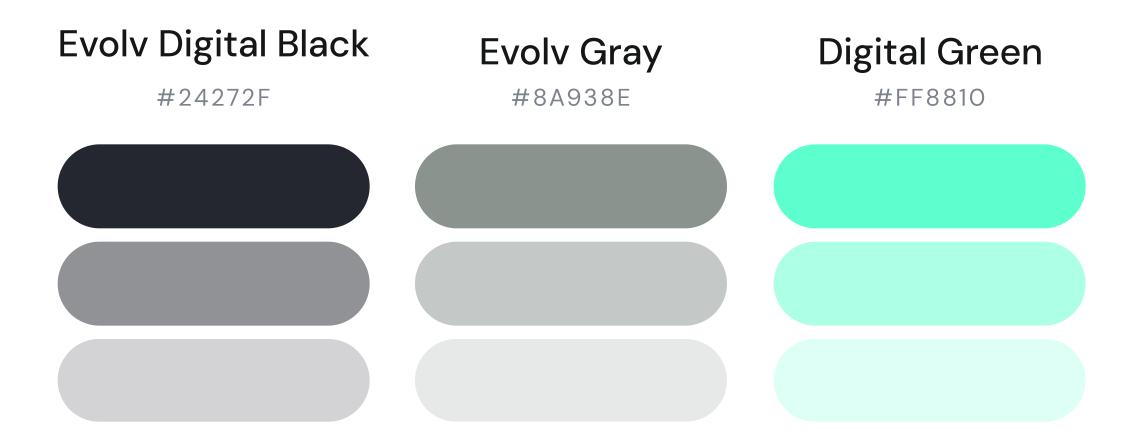
Our approach to differentiating Evolv's industry verticals will involve using designated ratios of primary colors for Sports, Healthcare, and Education.



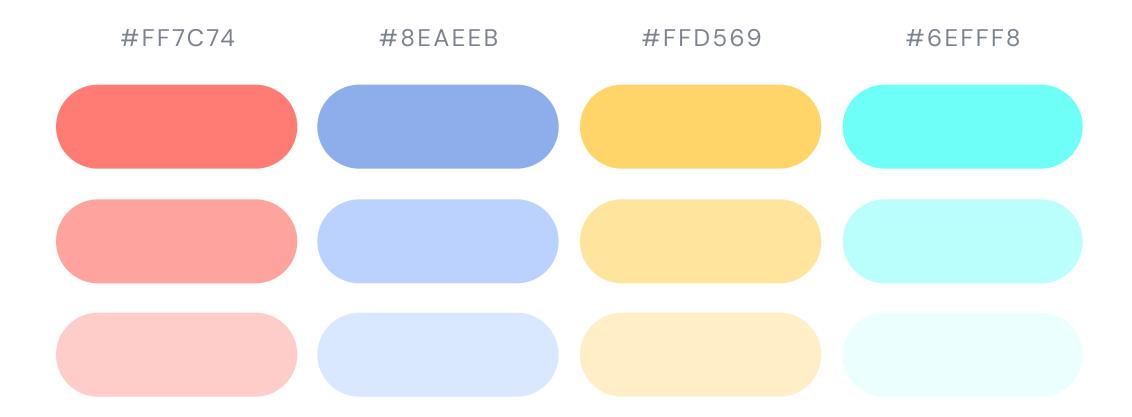
In-App Colors

By expanding the color palette into tints, we allow more flexibility in the app design.



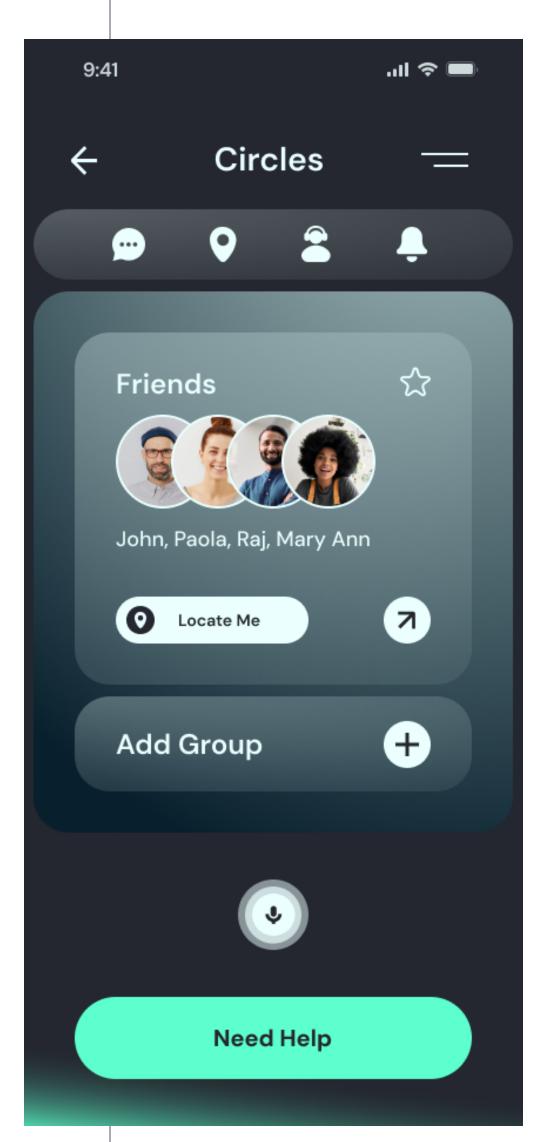

Comforting

Look for photography that feels natural and utilizes warm lighting. Avoid artificial and cold lighting.

Human

Look for opportunities to capture authentic candid interactions that evoke the freedom that Evolv affords.

Movement

Capture the Evolv experience by showing the ease, flow, and security Evolv affords at favorite locations and events.

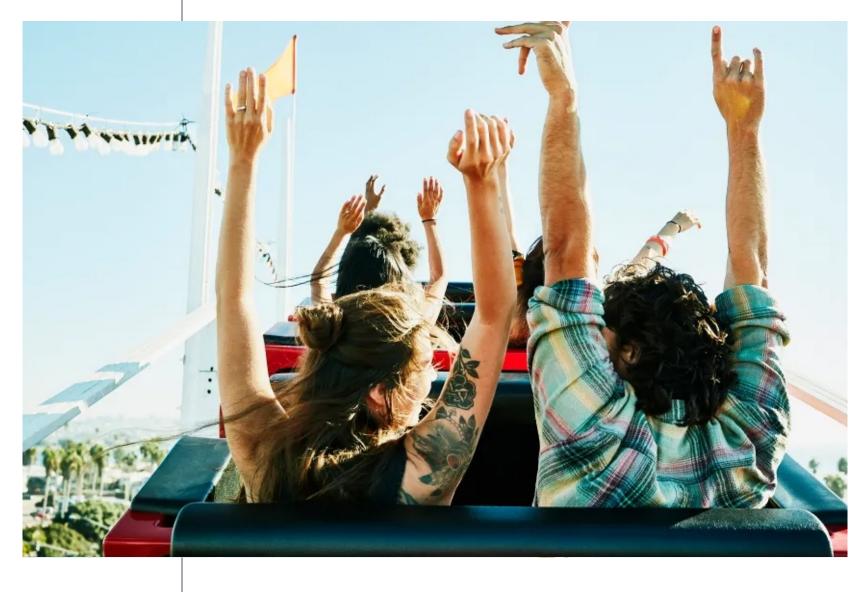
Photography People

Look for photos that embody the positivity reflected in our mission. People should feel candid and comfortable. The lighting should feel warm and optimistic. Framing should offer varied perspectives, and utilize depth of field to bring attention to subjects in crowded places. Be sure to show diversity in age, gender, and ethnicity.











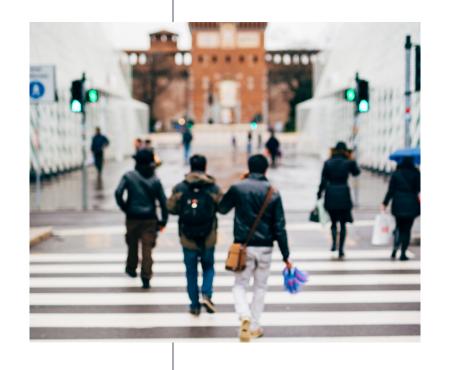


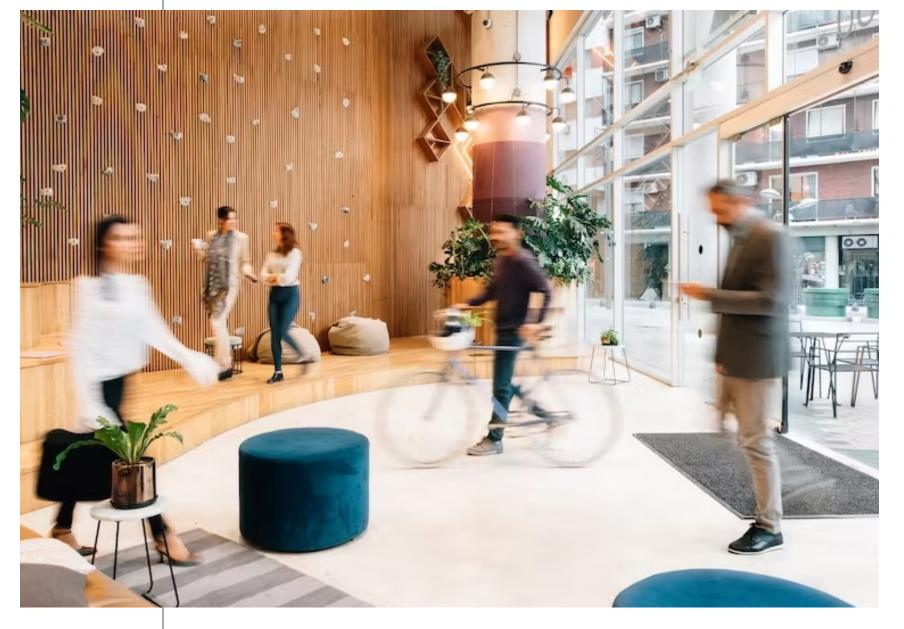

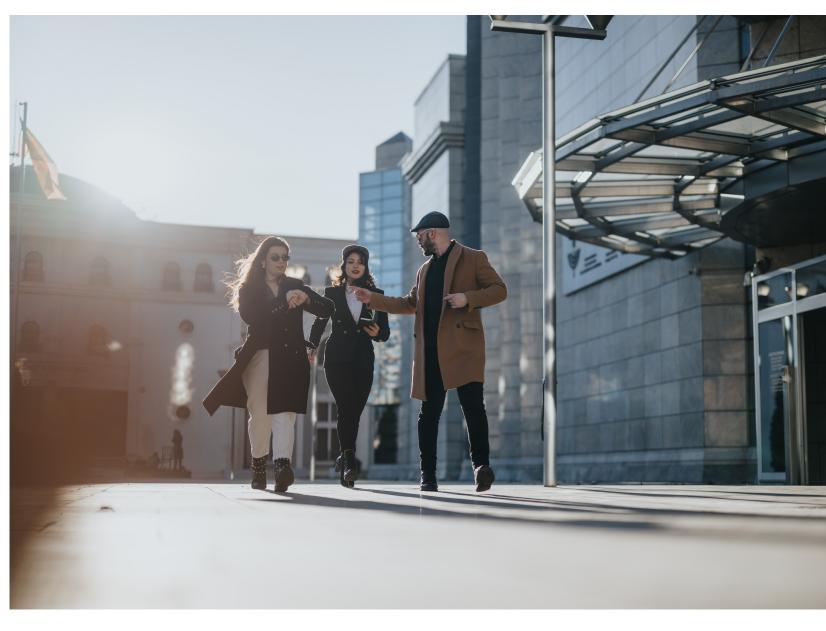
Contextualized imagery shows the product being used in real-life environments.

Threshold Pattern

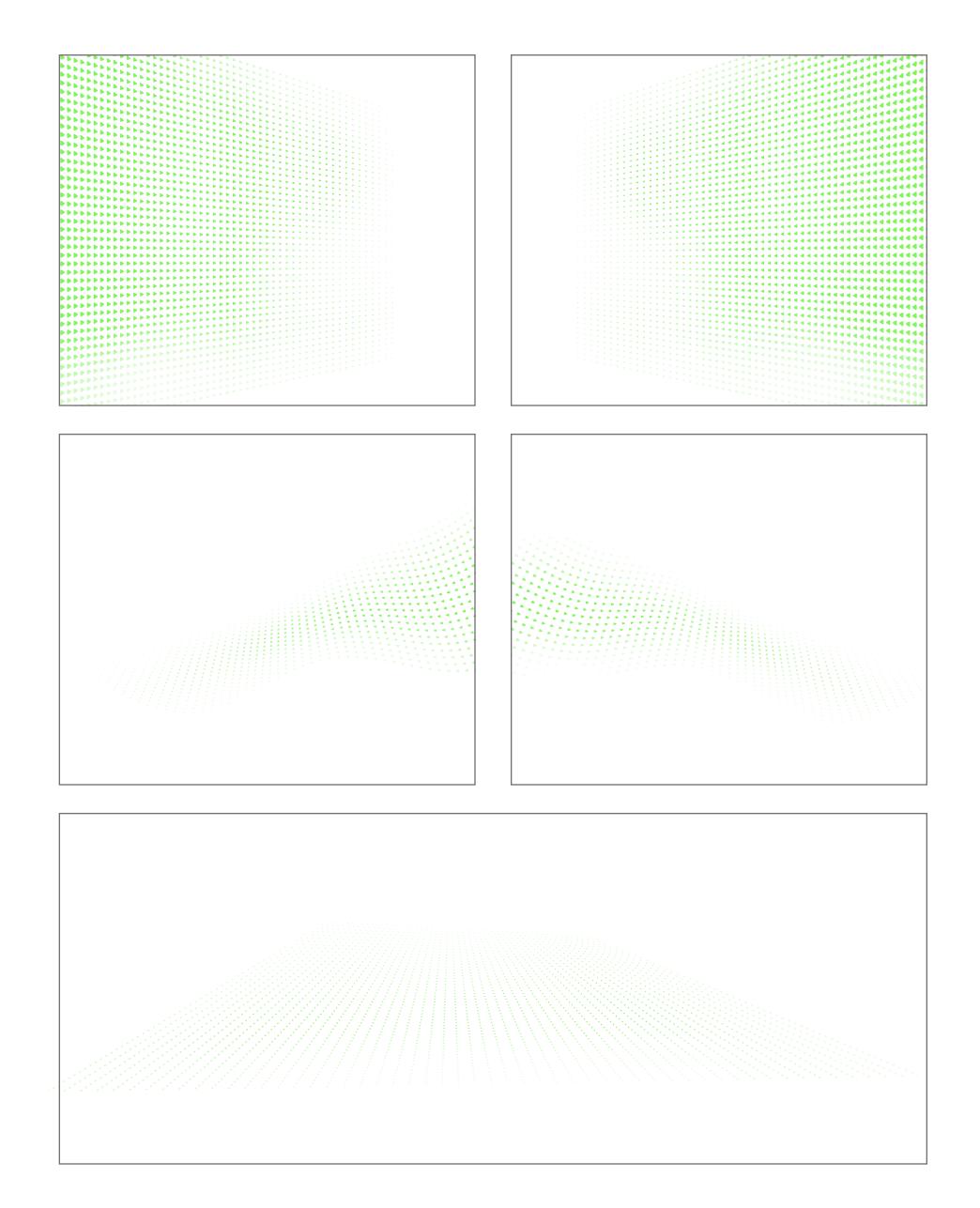
The Threshold Pattern represents the seamless flow of guests through the Evolv Express® systems.

USAGE RULES

Threshold Pattern

There's a few rules to abide by when using the Threshold Pattern.

- Only use with an image of the Evolv Express to indicate flow or in place of people walking through the system. Do not use as isolated decorative elements.
- Do not separate or modify the existing approved crops.
- Do not layer with the lon Pattern.
- Do not use the Threshold Pattern on an Evolv Express system panel if there is already a Threshold Pattern or Ion Pattern in the background or behind the system image.
- It should always be flowing off the edge or a corner of the page. There should be no visibly hard lines on the pattern.
- The Threshold pattern should flow in the direction people would be walking.
- The Threshold pattern should look like it is flowing through the lanes, so the pattern should be on top of the further away parts of the machine.
- The Threshold pattern should feel fluid.
- When there is a logo on the panels, have the pattern be lower down, and tad smaller. That way the logo is not covered up.
- When using a dual-lane system, the pattern should be flowing through both lanes .







Ion Pattern

The Ion Pattern is a halftone-style field of dots with gradation in dot size and spacing to provide more depth. It can be used with or without system images.

USAGE RULES

Ion Pattern

Overall, the Ion Pattern has less rules and more flexibility since it can be used separately from the Express system.

- It can be used with or without Evolv Express system images, but it should not overlap the Threshold pattern.
- Do not separate or modify the existing approved crops.
- Do not layer with the lon Pattern.
- Do not use the Ion Pattern on an Evolv Express system panel if there is already a Threshold Pattern or Ion Pattern in the background or behind the system image.
- It should always be flowing off the edge or a corner of the page. There should be no visibly hard lines on the pattern.

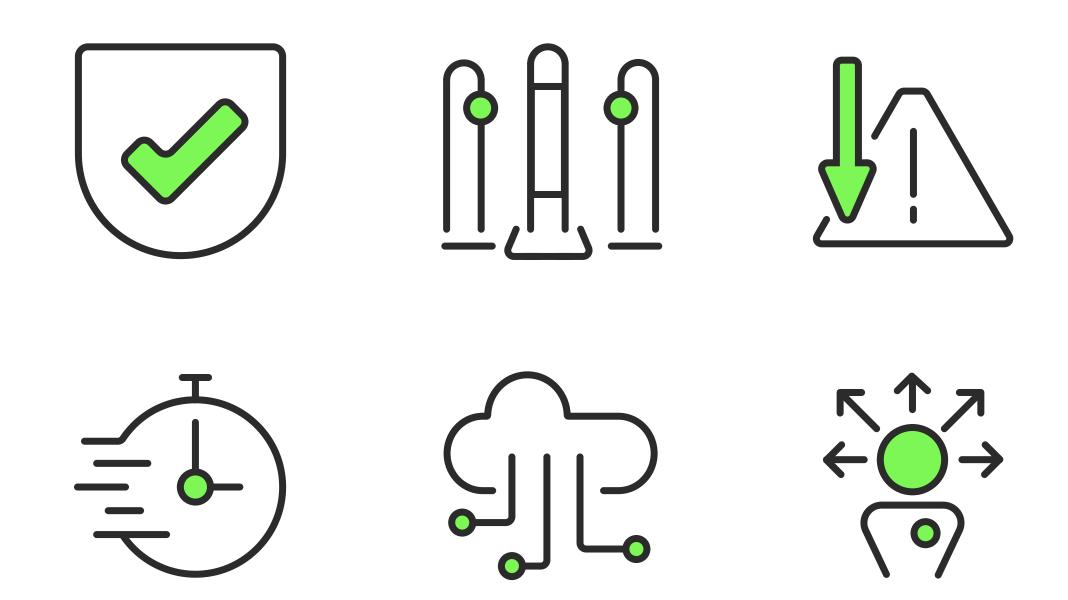

Customer Logos

Brands are important. Representing another company's brand in ads, PPT slides, in videos, on the website, and more is a privilege and one that Evolv does not take for granted. Using customer logos without written permission constitutes trademark infringement and can result in the loss of those customers, or even a lawsuit. For this reason, it is important that these rules are followed no matter what the use case:

- Logo MUST be approved per official contract (see spreadsheet for approved logo usage)
- Logo must not be altered
- Logo cannot be placed on top of an image
- If using an NFL team logo, it cannot appear in conjunction with ANY other team logo (no matter the league)
